### 8. BUS SHELTERS

After some discussion Clir. Mason-Hornby proposed the Council should apply to Capita for funding of two bus shelters, first on the southbound carriageway of the A6070 at the entrance to Glebe Close, the second on the northbound carriageway at the Green Dragon. This was seconded by Cllr.Wren. The proposal was carried by 3 votes to one against and one abstention. The Clerk was asked to convey the decision to Cllr. Hopwood & to reply to a member of the public who had written objecting to the Creamery site proposal

The Chairman explained the current contract expires at the end of January. He and the Chairmen of Holme & Endmoor Parish Councils have agreed a Scheme to put to CCC & CALC at a meeting with them on 27 November. He will report back at the next Parish Council Meeting

12. BALLOT FOR PARISH REPRESENTATIVE ON CALC SOUTH LAKELAND STANDARDS COMMITTEE Cllr.Wren proposed Cllr.Isherwood and as there were no other proposals it was unanimously agreed his name should be entered onto the ballot paper, signed by the Chairman & Clerk & returned to CALC (CD)
