- Clir Boddy reported back on the Cumbria Waste Development proposals. He also urged people to join the University Hospitals of Morecambe Bay Foundation Hospital Trust and gave the Clerk a notice of a meeting to be held on 10 January 2008 for the parish notice board (CD)
- Cllr.Isherwood reported the application for a bus shelter was ongoing
- Cllr. Wren requested the Clerk write to Persimmon requesting the faulty lights on Caterpillar Walk be repaired
