10) LENGTHSMAN'S LOG OF PLAYGROUND INSPECTION, REVIEW OF ACTION ITEMS, AND REPORTS FROM PARISH, COUNTY AND DISTRICT COUNCILLORS:

- a) County & District Cllr Bingham updated the Council on County and District Council Matters. The library van was no longer available and it is hoped that once a month there will be a library service in the BMH. Cllr Bingham has requested £3500 towards the traffic calming work required at Boon Town/Main Street Junction.
- b) Cllr Moira Rowley updated the Council on the Rec Trust fundraising 10K. There was a good turnout and funds raised were approximately £850. A local farmer has reported a problem with Ragwort on the Motorway boundary fence. A letter will be sent to Highways to report this. (CD)

A meeting at the playground took place recently and a recommendation has been given to install grassmat and grass the area around the zip wire which is currently woodchip. This will be added to the Outstanding Items to be actioned.

Cllr Rowley has been offered a free seesaw that has been taken from Kirkbarrow playground. It was agreed that Cllr Rowley get a price for installation of the seesaw.


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- c) Cllr Paul Rogers informed the council that Caterpillar Walk overgrown areas have now been cut back. The moss will be scraped from the pavements in due course.

White lines have been painted on Dalton Lane, but still the junction markings to be completed.

- d) Cllr Francis Mason-Hornby asked that the grass around the signage south of the village on the A6070 be cut back.
- e) Cllr George Isherwood requested a letter be sent to SLDC Highways Department under the Freedom of Information Act regarding the resurfacing of the A6070 at Clawthorpe and the reasons this work was carried out (CD).
- f) Cllr Alan Wren reported the street light on Neddy Hill is out and buzzing. Cllr Wren also requested that weeds around the Market Cross be sprayed. Cllr Rogers to inform the Lengthsman (PR)
