7) HOLME PARK QUARRY TIME EXTENSION APPLICATION
Development Control Committee Report and Ready Mixed Concrete Plant
Variation of Condition Application.

Councillor Rogers reported that he and the lengthsman had dug out one gully on Morewood drive that was full of soil and there were others like this. It was agreed that the Clerk would write to Highways with this report and also report each problem on the website to try to get this problem sorted.
