12) LENGTHSMAN'S LOG, REVIEW OF ACTION ITEMS AND REPORTS FROM PARISH, COUNTY, DISTRICT AND COUNCILLORS AND CLERK.

- a) County Councillor Bingham informed the Parish Council that a County Administration had now been formed with the Liberal Democrats and Labour. Ongoing issues he is currently dealing with include Church Bank development, drains and parking issues on Vicarage Lane.
- b) Councillor Rowley reported that the Team Challenge day had raised approximately £1500 despite the weather and that the resurfacing of the MUGA is hopefully going to start in October.
- c) Councillor Rogers reported:
- i) Hedge outside 'The Cottage' has been cut after a request was made.
 - ii) SLDC has swept Main Street
 - iii) Cllr Rogers has cut back the Flowering Bush behind the 'Burton' sign on Station Lane.
 - iv) Surface water drains on Main Street North of The Square completely blocked by large stones. A camera put down either end of the blockage caused by a collapse of drain in the Royal car park. The road will now be dug up to repair.
 - v) Fly tipping of a fridge on Tarn Lane – reported to Lancaster City Council.
- d) Councillor Hopwood attended a CALC day on common land which she found very interesting and informative. Whilst there she spoke to the Clerk from Millom regarding their relationship with the local Quarry.
