Councillor Hughes will bring this to Highways attention and request a visit to assess the speed limits. This will now be added to 'Outstanding Items' and can therefore be discussed each month.

10) AGREE THE LOCATION OF THE NEW CORONATION BENCH

Following a site visit, Councillors agreed the bench should be on the verge in front of the School. Cllr Taylor will supply bases for the bench. Once in place a plaque will be considered.

11) CONSIDER REPLACEMENT OF BENCHES AT BOON TOWN AND STATION LANE

The 2 benches located at Boon Town and Station Lane are no longer safe to use. It was agreed that prices would be obtained for 2 new benches to be considered at the September meeting.
